Cell Phone Policy July 2021



The Riverside Public Library understands cell phones have become a vital component of communication, and responsible cell phone use is permitted within the library building. Patrons are directed to turn ringers to vibrate or silent, maintain a library-appropriate voice level, and keep conversations brief. Extended length phone calls should be taken outside of the Library. Speaker phones and video calls are not allowed in the Library. The Riverside Public Library reserves the right to ask anyone to discontinue phone use in the Library.
